PEDESTRIAN INJURED BY HIT AND RUN DRIVER

Subject injures pedestrian with vehicle and then crashes vehicle into tree.

On February 16, 2008 at 12:22 p.m. Milwaukie Police responded to a pedestrian that had been hit by a vehicle on SE 43rd near SE Logus. Officers found that a female had been struck by a hit and run driver. The driver fled the scene after the crash and subsequently crashed his vehicle into a tree on SE 34th and SE King Rd.

The victim, a 52-year-old female from Milwaukie, was walking on SE 43rd north of SE Logus when she was struck by a Ford pickup southbound on SE 43rd. The vehicle was driven by a 20-year-old male who left the scene.

The suspect subsequently crashed his vehicle into a tree on SE 34th and SE King Rd. Both the suspect and victim were transported by ambulance to OHSU. Both are listed in critical condition at the hospital.

The incident is being investigated by Milwaukie Police and the Clackamas County CRAFT team. Alcohol appears to be a factor and the incident is still under investigation. No charges have yet been filed.
