PRESS RELEASE

On February 11, 2005 two suspects were arrested for graffiti in the area of SE Linwood and SE Harmony. Those suspects were responsible for thousands of dollars in damage to businesses, residences and utilities.

Milwaukie Police have now identified a third suspect in the vandalism. Police believe that Shane S. Culp, 25, of Milwaukie is responsible for a series of graffiti "tags" that appeared in a wide area from the Milwaukie industrial area to SE 82nd Ave.

The suspect used the tags RUSTO DE, DOLLAR 1 and HMOB. Damage is estimated to be at least \$5,000 and at least 50 individual tags have been attributed to the suspect.

The suspect has been interviewed and has been charged with felony Criminal Mischief and is in custody at the Yamhill County jail on unrelated charges.

The case will be referred to the Clackamas County grand jury. Milwaukie Police are asking anyone that has seen similar tags to contact the Milwaukie Police Department at 503-786-7500.
