Milwaukie Police will be presenting awards to two members of the department at a Milwaukie City Council meeting on June 20, 2005 at 7:00 p.m.

The department will be honoring Sgt. Dave Rash with a Meritorious Service Medal. Sgt. Rash has made a 5-year long effort to establish Milwaukie Police Department training management and proficiency standards. This standard has not only established a training program for Milwaukie Police Department but has provided training coordination for the Clackamas County Public Safety Training Council. His leadership established a standard never before reached by the Training Council.

Through his efforts Sgt. Rash also helped Milwaukie Police receive an award from Crime Stoppers, Inc. for Milwaukie Police Department's support of the regional Crime Stoppers effort. For the past 5 years Crime Stoppers has paid rewards for information involving Milwaukie cases.

Milwaukie Police Department will also be recognizing Sgt. Terry Marthaller (Ret.) for his voluntary work in the Milwaukie Police Department's Property Room. After retiring from the department in 2000, Sgt. Marthaller returned in 2005 and donated hundreds of hours in an effort to restore accountability to property handling procedures and helped establish a bar code system to manage the property room.

Both officers will be honored at the June 20, 2006 City Council Meeting at Milwaukie City Hall in the council chambers, 10722 SE Main, Milwaukie at 7:00 p.m. The media is invited to attend.
