## **PRESS RELEASE**

On April 6, 2006 Milwaukie Police investigated the burglary of a business in the 4200 block of SE International Way. One suspect in the burglary was arrested by Clackamas County Sheriff's Office after a pursuit on a \$30,000 motorcycle taken from the business later the same day.

Milwaukie Police detectives conducted an in depth investigation into the burglary in which the suspects broke into the business and a motor home on the property three separate times during the same night and removed property from the business valued at \$14,000.

Property taken from the business included, the specialized racing motorcycle, motorcycle gear, 4X4 tires, truck parts, video games and components, as well as other property.

In the course of the investigation detectives executed a search warrant at a residence in the 12600 block of SE 39<sup>th</sup> in Milwaukie. At that residence and at a residence in Portland the stolen property was recovered.

Five adult suspects were arrested in the crime. A 16-year-old juvenile is also a suspect and his disposition is pending from Clackamas County juvenile. The adults arrested were:

Casey Victor Fowler, 19, from Portland, charged with 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> degree Burglary and charged in Clackamas County in the theft of the motorcycle.

Michael Jeffrey Evans, 18, from Portland, charged with 2<sup>nd</sup> degree Burglary and 2<sup>nd</sup> degree Theft.

Gerald Gene Hereim, 19, from Portland, charged with Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle and 1<sup>st</sup> degree Theft.

Brian Vincent Carsner, 19, from Portland, charged with 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> degree Burglary and 1<sup>st</sup> degree Theft.

Drew Thomas Anthony, 21, from Milwaukie, charged with 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> degree Burglary and 1<sup>st</sup> degree Theft.

The case is set to go before the Clackamas County grand jury next week.
