## MILWAUKIE POLICE AND RAILROAD POLICE CONDUCTING CROSSING ENFORCEMENT.

Milwaukie Police and Union Pacific Railroad are teaming up to conduct enforcement of railroad crossings in Milwaukie.

Milwaukie Police Department and the Union Pacific Railroad Police are participating in a joint operation to enforce railroad crossing laws. On June 26, 2008 from 3:15 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. the two agencies will be focusing on railroad crossings in Milwaukie.

This operation is part of region wide enforcement of railroad crossings designed to selectively target traffic violations at Union Pacific railroad crossings. During this time all four of the crossings in Milwaukie will be utilized and officers will be looking for violations that could result in serious incidents between motorists and rail trains.

Fines for crossing violations can range from \$97 to \$242. This effort has been conducted since June 24, originating in Eugene OR.
