PEDESTRIAN SERIOUSLY INJURED AFTER BEING STRUCK BY CAR.

Pedestrian is seriously injured after being struck by vehicle.

On January 17, 2007 at 8:14 p.m. a pedestrian suffered serious injuries after being struck by a vehicle. The victim was crossing SE Frontage Rd. in the 9800 block when a southbound full size Ford pickup hit him.

The victim, Jeffrey Mitchell Scott, 30, of Portland was transported by ambulance to OHSU with serious head and leg injuries. The driver of the vehicle was James August Kanne, 61, of West Linn.

Milwaukie Police investigated the crash and determined that the victim, wearing all dark clothing, crossed the road in front of the vehicle in a non-marked area. The driver was unable to stop before hitting the victim.

No citations were issued and speed and alcohol do not appear to be factors. The driver of the vehicle was not injured. The victim is currently in stable condition at OHSU.
