## POLICE INVESTIGATE SUSPICIOUS DEATH

Milwaukie Police investigate suspicious death at local business.

On February 28, 2008 at 10:23 a.m. Milwaukie Police responded to a report of a subject not breathing at WW Metal Fab, 2200 SE Mailwell. Officers and medical personnel arrived to find a male subject deceased at the business.

The incident was investigated by the Milwaukie Police Department, Milwaukie Police Detectives, the Clackamas County Major Crimes Team and the Clackamas County Medical Examiner.

The death was suspicious in nature and a person of interest was originally sought in the case.

Milwaukie Police have identified the victim only as a 48-year-old Milwaukie man. He died of homicidal violence. The person of interest is no longer being sought.

Investigators are now questioning a suspect in relation to the case. The relationship of the suspect to the victim is not being released at this time.

For a time this afternoon schools in Gladstone were in lockdown as a precaution. It was thought that the suspect might be in the area of the schools. Those lockdown have been lifted.

Identification of the victim is not being released pending notification of family members. The suspect has not been formally charged at this time and identification is being withheld at this time.

The investigation is continuing.
