City Hall Sculpture Garden
Milwaukie, Oregon
Deadline: March 12, 2010**

The City Hall Sculpture Garden will be the first permanent art garden in the City of Milwaukie. Located on the south lawn of City Hall and adjacent to Jackson Street, the Milwaukie Sculpture Garden will provide a beautiful and interesting feature for nearby bus riders and visitors to downtown Milwaukie. This exciting project will be constructed in May-June of 2010 in conjunction with the re-construction of Jackson Street. Sculpture pieces will be installed in July-August depending on artist schedule and coordination with the Jackson Street project. *Gardens by Rebecca* has been selected to create the garden design which is being finalized currently.

The garden will contain 6 pedestals to display work, with half the work being replaced annually with new pieces. For the first round of pieces the Milwaukie Arts Committee (knows as "artMOB") is seeking works that are "kinetic" in nature. Pieces should have some movement and can be powered by people, rain, wind, solar, or other means.
